Armani is a 4-year-old golden retriever that is a professional therapy dog. Her person, Sherri, is a special education teacher, and Armani goes to work with her every day to provide services to Sherri's students. Armani's duties include providing a friendly face and a little love to anyone in need. As with other therapy dogs, Armani seems to sense which student is having a bad day and will go and sit quietly by them, putting her head in their lap. She has been instrumental in helping students overcome their fear of dogs, help them learn self-control, and of course, she provides unconditional love.

Armani has recently been diagnosed with soft-tissue sarcoma, grade 2. She has been given a 90% chance of survival with 16-18 radiation treatments over a 4-wk. period. The cost is approx. \$4,000. Sherri is a single mother of 3 children who received only 3 months child support last year. She is desperately trying to raise the money for Armani's treatment. The university vet hospital that can provide the needed treatment will not begin treating until she has 60% of the cost, which is \$2400.
